### What Type of Quilt Should I Bring to the Quilt Barn? (Glad that you asked!)

Let's review a few points! All styles of quilts are welcome – both rich, traditional as well as fresh, modern designs. Either way, the quilt design and the quilting are equally as important.

Queen and King-sized quilts sell the best of the bed quilts although there is a need for all sizes. Lap/Sofa quilts tend to sell the least but if you add a hanging sleeve to one of these quilts, we can promote it as a wall quilt as well! Baby quilts sell particularly well especially if they use current, color palettes. Holiday quilts (Christmas, Harvest, Halloween, etc.) also have a market.

Wall Hangings sell very well! Be sure to sew a hanging sleeve on the back of these quilts. Also, remember that you must submit at least one bed-sized quilt to submit any wall hangings.

We do receive questions about what colors to use in the quilts. My best suggestion is to focus on *classic* color combos and *home-friendly* palettes. Touch base with me if you have any questions or would like to discuss ideas!

## **Quilt Insight**

There have been many questions about requirements for quilting of the QB quilts. Many customers to the Quilt Barn – especially return customers – want to see and buy hand-quilted quilts. For many, this is what they associate with quilts offered in the QB. It's been only within the past 5 years or so that we've accepted machine-quilted quilts. However, I know that machine quilting has now risen to a different level. Many machine quilters have studied and practiced elevating their skills to be exceptional. We had several examples of that expertise represented within the Top 24 Winning Quilts of 2022! The quilting was hand-guided, customized designs that were truly beautiful. These stunning examples help to educate QB customers to show that both hand and machine quilting can be beautiful.

Here are some tips for hand or machine quilting:

#### Hand Quilting

- Small, even stitches
- Buried knots
- Thread color to enhance quilt design
- Fill the space well!

#### Machine Quilting

- Long arm or domestic machine quilting accepted
- Hand-guided, custom quilting is preferred looking for creativity/artistry
- Well executed pantograph quilting will be *considered* but these quilts are not eligible for judging
