
## WELCOME FESTIVAL SEASON!

## Prepping your quilts for the Quilt Barn

#### Clean Quilts:

Quilters are very careful about the condition of the quilts that they make. After all, these quilts mean a lot to us! Please check your quilts for any spots or stains *before* bringing them on registration day. Look for any snags or threads caught between the quilt layers that shadow through the fabric. There is no time to clean or repair quilts during registration. Our customers trust that we offer only the best and we work hard to keep their trust!

#### Hanging Sleeves:

Hanging sleeves are required for the backs of wall hangings. We also strongly encourage sleeves for the backs of crib and lap quilts. This small detail can make the difference between a sale or no-sale! Note that hanging tabs (loops) are not acceptable. Sleeves support the entire weight of the quilt and prevent stretching that can occur when using tabs.

#### **Inventory List and Information Tags:**

You will receive a receipt for each quilt that we accept in the QB. If you're bringing more than a few quilts, you may also find it helpful to prepare an inventory list of the quilts that you're bringing. You can write the receipt number next to each listing. This type of list helps both you and us if you come back to pick up any unsold items.

Information tags can also be extremely helpful during the registration process. A simple, paper tag safety pinned to the back of a quilt with the following can keep things moving along:

- ~ Quilter name ~ Name of quilt or quilt pattern
- ~ Quilt size & color ~ Price
