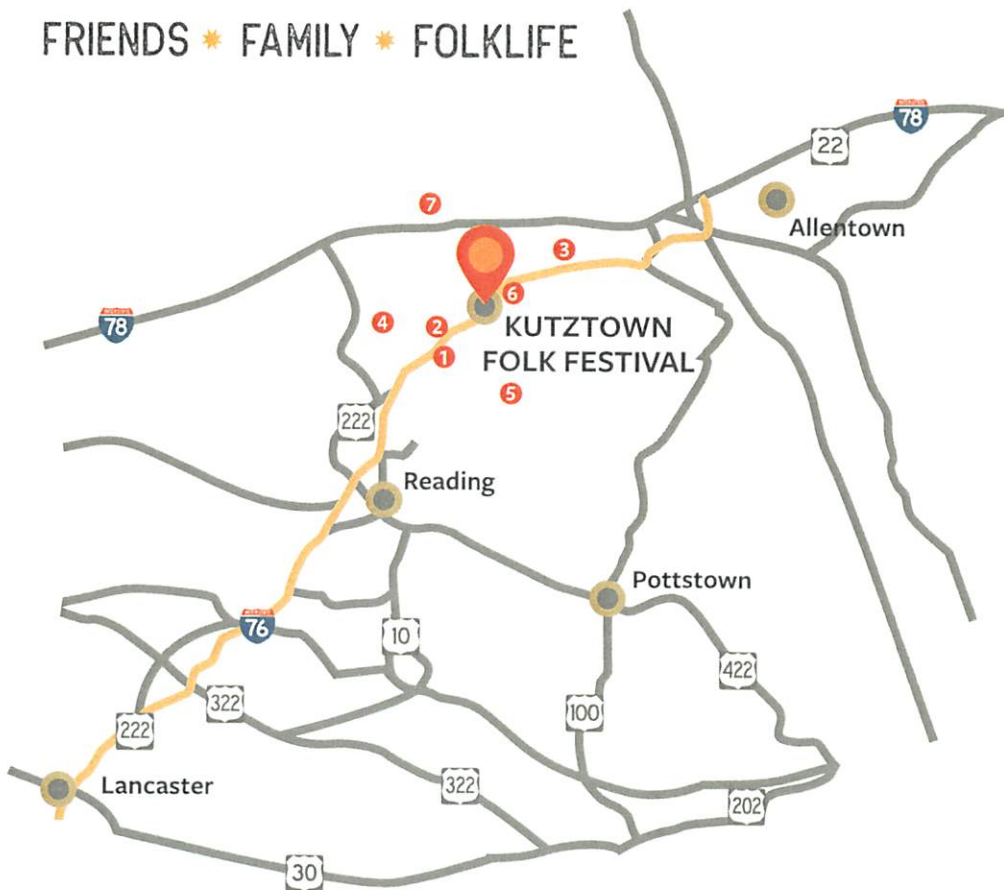
Open 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily | Kutztown Fairgrounds
